Color Tip: Wella Color Tango is a richer and more opaque color result in comparison to Wella Color Charm. If you are currently using Wella Color Charm, we recommend selecting a Wella Color Tango shade that is 1 level lighter than your existing shade to avoid getting results that are too dark. Remember to mix Wella Color Tango in a 1:1 mixing ratio and process for 30 minutes.
